

## CAMPGROUND RULES

1. Check-in time is 2 PM for sites and 4 PM for Cabins & GWL.
2. Maximum stay is 14 days.
3. Moving from one campsite to another is not permitted without prior approval from the campground main office.
4. Maximum Occupancy Strictly Enforced:  
Campsite - Maximum of 8, Cabin ADA - Maximum of 3,  
Cabin - Maximum of 8, GWL - Maximum of 14. Occupancy numbers apply during the entire length of stay (day and night).
5. You must be in some type of camping equipment.  
(Sleeping in cars is not permitted.)
6. Because camping is an outdoor activity, Carowinds does not give refunds due to discomforts of nature.
7. One RV and one tow vehicle are allowed per site. Vehicles must be in designated parking spaces (no parking on the road, on the grass, etc.) Additional parking space is available by the main lodge.
8. Please avoid parking on the grass.
9. Obey posted speed limits.
10. For the comfort and rest of all our guests, please observe a quiet time between the hours of 11 PM. and 8 AM.
11. Skateboards and roller blades are not permitted.
12. Golf carts cannot travel beyond the main lodge and drivers must be at least 16 years of age.
13. Pets are required to be on a leash at all times and shall not constitute a danger to other guests. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET IMMEDIATELY. Pets are not allowed inside campground facilities or the swimming pool / playground areas. Pets are not allowed to be left on the site unattended.
14. Motorcycle riding is allowed, only when traveling to and from your campsite.
15. Alcoholic beverages must be consumed on renter's site only.
16. Firearms and fireworks are strictly prohibited. Private property prohibits the carrying of any firearm, regardless of permit.
17. No ground fires are allowed. Fires for preparing food must be contained inside each site's grill. Firepits can be rented at Lodge Trading Post.
18. Protect our trees and please assist us in keeping our grounds clean. Please remove ropes from trees and utilize the dumpster stations to rid your trash prior to leaving.
19. Washing of cars and campers is prohibited.
20. The washing of clothes, diapers, food utensils, etc is forbidden in the bathhouses.
21. Destroying or damaging campground property, cutting trees, jamming machines or disturbing guests is not permitted and is grounds for campground dismissal.
22. All indoor facilities are smoke free, (including cabins).
23. Radios are not permitted in the lodge.
24. Carowinds assumes no responsibility for accidents or injuries of any nature.
25. We reserve the right to terminate the stay of any guest for any behavior that creates a disturbance, or for infraction of these rules, governmental laws and regulations and/or other violation of campground safety policies.
26. Tram available for campers only. Wristband is required.
27. Shirt, shoes, and shorts/pants must be worn inside Trading Post.

## CAMPGROUND INFORMATION

1. Security is available 24 hours a day. Should you need first aid or security, please check in the office. If we are closed, please use the phone located on the Trading Post porch for assistance. Security direct line after hours: 704.587.9018.
2. Carowinds is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
3. For your enjoyment and protection, please report infractions of rules and/or suspicious behavior to our office.
4. Please put all trash in dumpsters located throughout the campground.
5. For your convenience, the laundry room opens at 9 AM.
6. For reservation of site, cabin, or GWL a deposit of one nights stay is required.
7. Policies, rates and hours of operation subject to change without notice.
8. Weather updates can be found at the lodge via local and national weather services. In the event of severe weather, area sirens from local emergency management will sound. Should this occur, seek shelter immediately.

## POOL RULES

*Pool open from Memorial Day thru Labor Day,  
see Reservation desk for pool hours.*

1. Always follow lifeguard instructions.
2. Failure to follow rules and instructions can result in serious injury to yourself and others.
3. Children under 42" must be accompanied by a chaperone.
4. No running, diving, or horseplay allowed.
5. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in the pool area.
6. Please do not bring food in the pool area.
7. Please do not bring glass containers into the pool area.
8. For the consideration of others, no smoking except in designated areas.
9. Bathing suits are required, sorry, no cutoffs.
10. Pool will close if inclement weather is in the area.
11. Pool opening and operation is subject to water temperature and quality standards.
12. It is advised to remove jewelry, watches, etc and secure them in a safe place
13. Life vests are available free of charge. Anyone under 48" tall is required to wear a life vest at all times.
14. Please shower before entering the pool.
15. Floats are not permitted in the deep end of the pool.
16. Please keep pets out of the pool area.
17. Wristbands required in pool area.

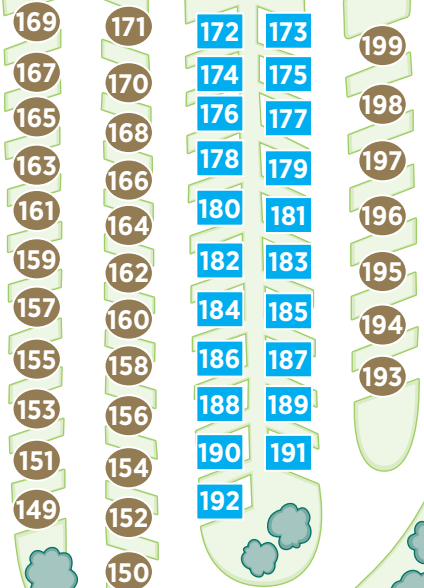
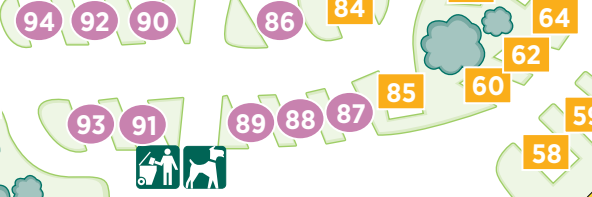
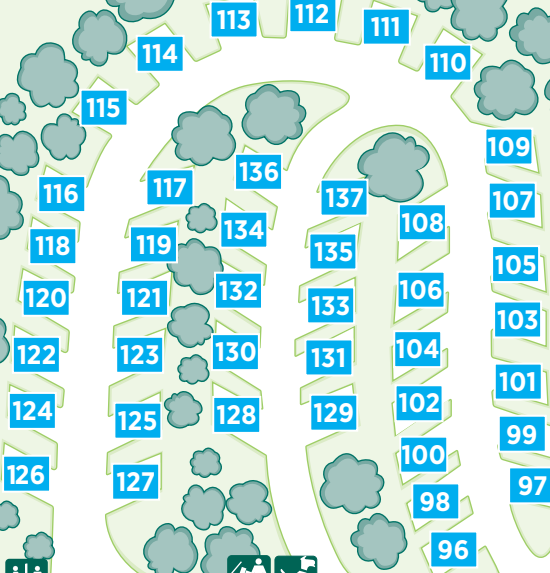
