SPECTATORS

Spectator entry is limited for practice days and game days to abide by the health orders of the local health department. All are required to follow all regulations when entering the building

- Face Coverings Required
- Practice Days (1 spectator/child) Game Days (3 spectators/child) permitted
- Volunteers do not count towards a child's allotted spectator

SAFETY GUIDLENINES

The staff will follow all safety guidelines and sport regulations throughout the season in order to provide a safe and healthy environment

- Face Coverings Required for all spectators (ages 10-up) and athletes when not playing
- All game day staff will be temperature tested before entering building
- Equipment will be sanitized before use of each practice/game session
- Game balls will be sanitized frequently during game play
- Bleachers/Benches will be sanitized between each practice/game session
- Coaches will promote individual skills throughout practice by use of individual equipment as much as possible (own ball)
- Participants are not permitted to enter building until 10-minutes prior to practice/game time
